



## TozziniFreire Advogados celebrates its 47<sup>th</sup> anniversary

Law firm TozziniFreire Advogados will celebrate its 47<sup>th</sup> anniversary this Wednesday, September 13<sup>th</sup>. With offices in São Paulo, Porto Alegre, Campinas, Brasília, Rio de Janeiro, and New York, it is one of Brazil's leading full-service law firms, with cases in all areas of business law and a relevant track record in assisting national and international companies from a wide range of sectors.

Founders Syllas Tozzini and José Luis de Salles Freire met in 1963 at Colégio Santo Américo, in São Paulo, went to Law School and began their careers at different law firms before they founded TozziniFreire in 1976, which currently has 55 practice areas and 25 sector groups, 98 partners and over 1,200 professionals.

With strong values associated with client relationship, innovation, diversity, and inclusion, TozziniFreire has a balance of men and women on its Executive Committee, and its legal and administrative departments are comprised by a majority of women: 63% and 67%, respectively.

Large transactions are part of TozziniFreire's DNA. The law firm was born and has grown conducting major Mergers & Acquisitions deals since its inception, in the late 1970s. It was ranked as the 2<sup>nd</sup> firm in Brazil in terms of the number of transactions registered, according to TTR Data in the first semester of 2023, has played a relevant role in many of the most significant operations conducted in Brazil, which have contributed to a growing economy over the past decades.

To celebrate this anniversary, TozziniFreire has delivered two new spaces to its Campinas and Brasília offices, apart from promoting a series of celebratory actions to mark the 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary of its innovation program, ThinkFuture.

The law firm is also celebrating 25 years of its international relationship program, known as TF Global, which has consolidated TozziniFreire as one of the most present and active firms in relationships with international partnerships, reaching all Asia, Europe, and the United States.
